- Type of Project: EU/FP 7 INCONET Support Action (building on MIRA)
- Main Objective: Contributing to the quality of the Euro-Mediterranean research area, with a particular focus on the biregional Euro-Mediterranean S&T cooperation, research & innovation, policy dialogue
- Special focus on three societal challenges: Water, Food, Energy
- **Partnership**: **28** partners from **17** countries. Decision makers (research ministries, research councils, research institutions, others)
- **Duration**: Feb. 2013- Jan 2017



Med-Spring milestones

- Med-Spring Agorà: permanent dialogue platform
 (www.agora.medspring.eu) through social media, strengthening and
 structuring the participation of civil society.
- EMEG (Euro-Mediterranean Expert Group): a thematic think-tank of more than 45 experts (NEXUS)
- **Supporting long-term cooperation**: linking and synergizing with other Euro-Mediterranean initiatives (ERANETs, Article 185, JPIs)
- Inter-Institutional, stakeholders & policy level dialogue: supporting exchange and dialogue on research cooperation across various actors, including EU regions.
- **Capacity building & brokerage**: training for trainers, demand-based capacity building and interactive brokerage events on innovation and H2020

Brokerage (Cairo, 2014; Berlin, 2015; Bari, 2016)

- Facilitate the link between research and innovation through the creation of privatepublic and research-enterprise partnerships
- Mobilize entrepreneurs in the host region and encourage clustering for innovation involving young entrepreneurs from the Mediterranean Partner Countries (MPCs).
- ✓ Increase the opportunities to establish new profitable contacts and offer participants a platform to:
 - Share knowledge, particularly research knowledge
 - Promote their technologies and experiences
 - Acknowledge the most innovative solutions
 - Develop cross-regional technological, commercial or research partnerships.


