

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

SUBJECT: <u>Instructions for the development of three digital platforms as part of the Lebanese national early warning system platform "NEWSP"</u>

The CIHEAM - Mediterranean Agronomic Institute of Bari (CIHEAM Bari), a body of the CIHEAM, an international intergovernmental organisation, with legal and operational headquarters in Italy at Via Ceglie n.9, Valenzano (BA), fiscal code VAT: 93047470724, in the framework of the international cooperation purposes of the Institute, intends to acquire early warning system (EWS) digital platforms divided into 3 lots, as specified in ANNEX I (Financial offer template).

A. Conditions of the offer:

- 1. The **language** to be used for drafting the offer, correspondence and documents is **English**. The Contract form will be sent in case of positive feedback to the offer sent by your Company.
- 2. The offer must be made for all the items, divided by individual lots. There will be 3 lots, subdivided as described in ANNEX I.
- 3. The offer may be in EURO.
- 4. The offer must be **quoted DAP** (Delivery At Place) included the implementation, following the procedure indicated at point 12 of this list. As highlighted in ANNEX I (Financial Offer Template), the offer must be divided into 3 lots, specified as follows:
 - (1) LOT 1 Develop a website for natural hazards
 - (2) LOT 2 Develop a mobile application for natural hazards "Leb-Haz", starting with "Leb-Fire" and "Leb-Quake"
 - (3) LOT 3 Develop a collector mobile application for civil defense
- 5. The offer must specify: **VAT and any other taxes are included**.
- 6. It is mandatory to **indicate** the **minimum warranty terms** of each product included in the price offered.
- 7. Any additional costs for warranty extension/additions MUST NOT BE PART OF THE OFFER but can be quoted as a separate option.
- 8. Indicate separately, if needed, the **recommended spare parts** and their cost per each item, according to the time of use.
- 9. It is mandatory to indicate the delivery time per each lot, from the contract signature's date, in total days (within a maximum of 4 months for the final deliverable).
- 10. The validity date of the offer must be at least 30 days and must be explicitly stated in the offer.
- 11. **Payment will be made in EURO by bank transfer:** it will be used the exchange rate applied by the bank at the time of payment. Please, verify your bank account can receive euros.
- 12. Payment will be made in three instalments:
 - a. **1**st instalment: 40% of the total amount of the accepted offer, paid after the <u>signature</u> of the contract.
 - b. 2nd instalment: 40% of the total amount of the accepted offer, upon the confirmed delivery of the beta version of the 3 lots specified in point 4 of this list.
 - c. **3rd instalment:** 20% of the total amount of the accepted offer, upon the confirmed successful testing.
- 13. The details for the payment must be indicated in the offer: Owner/Holder, Bank, C/C, Bank of support-swift code).
- 14. **Incomplete offers** that will not include all the mandatory information and technical documents (pointed out in the next list) **might not be taken into consideration**.





B. Mandatory technical documents to be included with the offer (in English language):

- 1. Technical sheets of each offered model (minimum specifications required or above) as per ANNEX II (RFP / Technical Specifications Paragraph VI);
- 2. Filled, signed and stamped financial offer template (ANNEX I).
- 3. Maintenance instructions and/or technical assistance service (including websites updates, mobile app updates to follow latest iOS and android software releases, systems backup, etc.);
- 4. Timetable of the planned work, indicating intermediate milestones (timing and name);
- 5. List of recommended spare parts and consumables (if any);
- 6. List and contacts of the authorised partners operating in delivery sites for inspection, repair, extraordinary and routine maintenance, etc. (if any).
- 7. Additional costs for warranty extension (if any).
- 8. Short written summary of the previous experience (last year) of implementation of similar projects in Lebanon on headed paper stamped and signed.
- 9. Registration certificate of the Supplier Company with the Chamber of Commerce.

C. Optional annexes to the offer (in English language):

9. Any other information.
